1. General information

3. The purpose of personal data processing and the legal basis for their processing

By using the CFD Toolbox for MATLAB Lite version free of charge, obtaining a trial license or purchasing a paid version of the program, we use your personal data to perform the contract (Article 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR).

When registering for webinars - in order to allow you access to webinars, we use your personal data based on your consent (Article 6 (1) (a) of the GDPR).

For marketing purposes, in particular in the area of newsletter sending, we use your personal data based on your consent (Article 6 paragraph 1 letter a) GDPR).

We use cookies to:

- a) matching the content of the website to the individual preferences of the user, first of all these files recognize his device in order to display the page according to his preferences;
- b) preparing statistics that help to know users' preferences and behaviors, analysis of these statistics is anonymous and allows you to adjust the content and appearance of the website to the prevailing trends, statistics are also used to assess the popularity of the site;

4. Recipients of personal data

Your personal data may only be transferred in accordance with the law, with all possible security guarantees, only to duly authorized entities (eg entities that process your personal data for the purpose of providing technical services necessary for the proper performance of the contract on our part).

5. The period during which personal data will be stored

Your personal data will be kept for the period necessary to achieve the objectives referred to in point 3 of the privacy policy.

6. Rights regarding personal data

To the extent provided by law, you have the option of requesting us to access your personal data, rectify, delete, transfer or limit processing, as well as object to processing.

In the event that the processing of your personal data is based on your consent, you are entitled to withdraw your consent at any time.

7. Complaint to the supervisory body

If you think that the processing of your data violates the GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (see in particular Articles 77 GDPR and Article 60 of the Act of 10 May 2018 on protection of personal data).
